All members are welcome to attend.

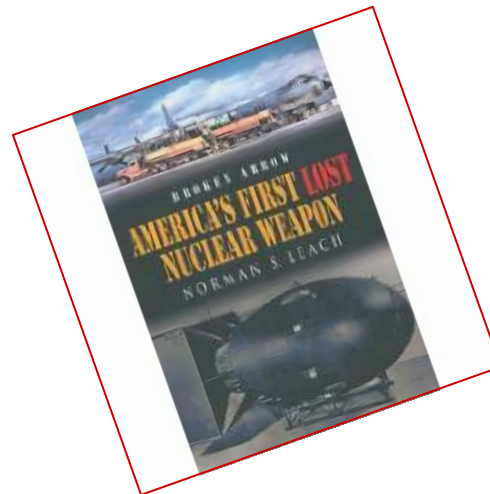

Tuesday, February 16th from 7 to 9 pm. in the Canfor Room.

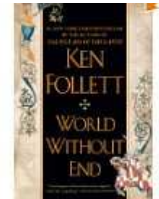
